

Dear FuseNet PhD Event 2025 attendees,

We are very excited to welcome you to the FuseNet PhD Event next week at ITER!  
All latest updated conference information is available on our [Indico website](#).

We would like to remind you that everyone must carry a valid ID document when visiting ITER: a passport or a government-issued ID for citizens of the Schengen area.

**This is the case for all three days!** Driver's licenses, professional badges or copies of ID documents are NOT accepted.

Please note that we will be using the following **security procedure** at ITER:

**Tuesday 4 November:**

Visitor badges will be issued at reception – passport/ID is obligatory.

While entering, you will be checked in with your QR code. You can find your QR code in the confirmation email you received from us.

Personalized event badges will be issued in the ITER lobby.

**Wednesday 5 November and Thursday 6 November:**

At the entry, event participants need to show their personalized event badge along with the visitor badge and passport/ID.

When passing the entry gate, you will be checked in with the QR code again, so please have it ready at the gate.

We have a water fountain during the event, so bring your own water bottle, filled at the hotel to avoid queues, which you can refill at the ITER site.

**Hotel information**

We have arranged the following hotel for you, unless we have notified you that you are in a different hotel:

- **The Odalys CITY Atrium, 15, Cours Gambetta. 13100 Aix-en-Provence, France.** At check-in, identify yourself as participant of the FuseNet PhD Event.

All transport to and from ITER will be arranged by us and will be done by bus.

**Tuesday 4 November**

- The buses will leave from the Originals hotel at **7:20 CET**.
- We will be heading to the dinner directly after the program at ITER so note that there will be no time to go to the hotel in between.

### **Wednesday 5 November**

- The buses will leave from the Originals hotel at 7:30 CET.
- The ITER tour is this morning. Please note that for safety reasons, skirts, shorts, open shoes or high heels are NOT permitted during the ITER worksite tour.
- In the evening, we will be having the Gala Dinner. There is no dress code for the dinner. Please note that the program at ITER will be directly followed by the evening program again, so we will not head to the hotel in between to change clothes.

### **Thursday 6 November**

The buses will leave from the Originals hotel at 8:00 CET.

The buses will return to the Hotels in Aix at 15:30 CET – arrival time depends on the traffic
